## Grasses

Native grasses provide the perfect complement to dry, prairie-like settings. Hybridized grasses work beautifully in landscaping and gardens. Foliage color ranges from green to variegated to blood red. From stunning vertical accents to low pin cushion-like varieties, these grasses have become the newest landscape rage. Generally, most prefer sun. Good drainage is essential for most varieties.
